

Barcelona will Host the III World Hospital at Home Congress 2023: The Present and Future of Remote Healthcare, Protagonist of the Meeting

- The meeting will address the latest technological developments that improve Hospital at Home field, from smart devices to remote monitoring of patients, to telecare.
- Other current issues and interests in the care modality will also be addressed, such as pediatric home hospitalization, patient safety, regulation, and ethical challenges, as well as economic efficiency of Hospital at Home.

Barcelona, January 3, 2023 The city of Barcelona will host the III World Hospital at Home Congress WHAHC 2023 from 30 March to 1 April 2023. This is the largest global scientific meeting on Hospital at Home, with more than 245 abstract submissions received and approximately 800 delegates expected to attend. The participants will hear presentations delivered by about 90 speakers coming from more than 20 countries.

Among the topics to be addressed at the meeting are the advances in remote care thanks to the development of health technology, clinical innovation, training of professionals, national policies and regulations on the care model or the experiences of patients and caregivers, among others.

Health technology will be one of the main protagonists of this WHAHC, since it will have its own space to address the most current issues in the field - the Hospital at Home Tech Summit, in which presentations will be held on solutions to improve identification and enrollment of patients in Hospital at Home, remote health care and optimization of virtual assistance, ways to leverage technology to scale the capacity of Hospital At Home and the effective use of technology to remotely monitor patients with this care model.

The latest healthcare and clinical developments in Hospital at Home will also be addressed at the WHAHC in Barcelona, such as advances in the treatment of cancer patients at home or home hospitalization of acute pediatric patients.

Another important focus in the program will be active listening to patients. Various relevant experiences of users and caregivers from France, USA and Singapore will be shared in the form of presentations.
